

FLYING BACK IN NETWORK – ASSISTED VOLUNTARY RETURN AND REINTEGRATION THROUGH THE TERRITORIAL NETWORK

THE PROJECT

The Flying Back in Network project aims to guarantee and support access to Assisted Voluntary Return And Reintegration (AVRR) for third country nationals, regular or irregular, including vulnerable persons, present in Italy, who decide to return home voluntarily.

The program guarantees:

- Counseling service for each migrant requesting return, including with the support of 13 IOM outreach operators throughout the country.
- The transfer of 2,500 migrants, assistance in obtaining travel documents and airport assistance upon departure and, if necessary, during transit and upon arrival.
- Distribution to each migrant an allowance equivalent to 615 euro in cash at departure for basic needs upon arrival in the country of origin.
- Support in the form of goods and services for reintegration projects, equivalent to 2,000 euro for individuals and heads of household, and 1000 euro for each child and dependent family members in the AVRR application.
- In close collaboration with IOM staff stationed in beneficiaries' country origin, provide advice and assistance in the elaboration and implementation of individual reintegration plans (PIR).
- Conduct informative training sessions on AVRR to key stakeholders in Italy to ensure when approached by potential beneficiaries, persons are well informed

and referral mechanisms are established.

- Build awareness activities on AVRR to third country national communities.
- Distribute AVRR information with brochures and a video.
- Activation of the toll-free telephone number 800 004 006.

PROJECT BENEFICIARIES

The beneficiaries of the project are:

- Third country nationals, with or without vulnerability, who can access the AVRR measure according to European and national rules.
- Public and private actors operating in the sector in relation to information/training activities.

The project, which will be active as of January 2, 2024, has a duration of 3 years and is managed by IOM Rome.
